

1) Introduction by chair, Senator Josh Miller

2) Discussion of legislative session

The group discussed last sessions legislative agenda which included reforming the fire code, and reenacting the SBA tax credit.

3) Discussion of next legislative session

The group discussed the possibility of supporting an override of the governor's veto of the coordinated health planning act. The group decided that the legislative workgroup should take this up.

The group also decided that reforming the fire code should stay on the agenda. IT was mentioned that this is especially important now that Rep. Ginaitt is stepping down.

The group decided that the SBA tax credit should also stay on the agenda. It was mentioned that the governor plans on putting it in his budget this session.

The group also discussed the possibility of supporting legislation that would streamline the licensing system in the state. Some possibilities include looking into ways to standardize forms across municipalities, move toward more electronic submissions.

A member informed the group that there will be another SBA Economic Summit on December 7th 2007.
