MINUTES OF MEETING

July 21, 2006

Open Session

The Open Session of the Board of Radiologic Technology was called to order at 8:30 am on the above date in Room 104, Cannon Building, Rhode Island Department of Health, Three Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Open Meeting Law, so called, and other applicable provisions of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, as amended.

The minutes of the meeting held on March 15, 2006 were presented.

On motion by Carol Kut, seconded by Mark Kershaw, it was unanimously voted to accept the Open Session minutes as presented.

Members discussed the issue of qualifications of individuals needed to operate the new PET/CT Scan machines. The Board agreed, pursuant to the current licensing law and rules/regulations, operation of PET/CT scan machines must be by a dually-licensed individual (both x-ray technician and nuclear medical technician) or by two (2) licensed individuals together (one (1) x-ray technician and one (1) nuclear medical technician). On a motion by Stephen Hiss, seconded by Mark Kershaw, the Board unanimously voted in agreement of the above.

Adjournment to Executive Session

On motion of Mark Kershaw, seconded by Carol Kut, it was unanimously voted to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to sections 42-46-4 and 42-46-5(1) of the Rhode Island General Laws, as Amended, in that confidential issues of fitness for licensure and investigative cases will be discussed. Complaint #RAD-01-2006 was discussed.

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Return to Open Session

The Open Session was called back to order.

On motion of Holly Haczynski, seconded by Stephen Hiss, it was unanimously voted to keep confidential all matters discussed in Executive Session and to seal those minutes inasmuch as fitness for licensure and ongoing disciplinary matters were addressed. Final Action: Complaint #RAD-01-2006 was dismissed with a finding of no unprofessional conduct.
