**1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 8:45 AM by a motion from Carol Kut and seconded by Mark Kershaw.**

**2. Review and Approval of Minutes – August 12, 2011:**

- **Issued Licenses – The list of new licenses was handed out. Motion to accept was made by Mark Kershaw and seconded by Carol Kut. All approved.**
- **The Rules and Regulations for Licensing of Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, Nuclear Medicine Technologists and Radiologist Assistants were filed on September 27, 2011 and took effect on October 17, 2011.**
- **Pertaining to Section 6.4 of said regulations with respect to competency in computed tomography (CT) training, a list of supplemental CT training providers is required to be approved by the Board and made available. After much discussion, information will be gathered and a list of CT training providers will be prepared and reviewed at the next Board meeting.**
- **The discussion continued regarding more specific options for obtaining CT training, as a question was raised about the possible burden in meeting these requirements while working full time in the profession. It was suggested that possibly a letter should be sent on behalf of the board to inquire about local schools that will provide training, which will be included on the above mentioned list. Information will need to be compiled first.**
