1. Andrea Mosher called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM.
2. Motion by Peter Clifford, seconded by Allan Klepper, to approve the minutes of 8/28/2012 passed unanimously.
3. New member William Layton was introduced to the committee followed by a general discussion of each member's CREB experience.
4. Committee decided to continue practice of rotating responsibility for keeping minutes.
- 5a. Committee members continue to collect data on existing brightfield projects with the intention of further discussion with the Town Council after the November elections.
- 5b. The next quarterly CREB/town official meeting will also be held after the November elections.
- 5c. The web sub-committee will meet to better define our desires for the CREB website then convey that information to Valerie Carroll for implementation.
- 5d. The general status of Police Cove was reviewed with nothing new to report.
- 5e. LED streetlights have been ordered for Maple Avenue. The concept of municipal ownership of streetlights is being discussed with other RI communities . The potential annual savings for Barrington is \$75,000 with a payback period of 2 to 3 years.
- 5f. EBEC is conducting a workshop in Bristol and preparing to propose a nonprofit organization to implement the windfarm.
