1. Call to Order at 7:37
2. Neither the June minutes nor October minutes were available for review.
3. No update on energy section of Barrington Comprehensive Plan, other than to indicate that the Planning Board is currently revising.
 - Quarterly meeting with town officials – next one has been scheduled for Weds Dec. 10th.
 - State Office of Energy Resources Municipal Working Group – Learned about how North Kingston saved money, that there is a push to remove barriers to energy efficiency improvements; that North Smithfield has a program to delay by 20 years the added valuation when solar panels are added to a residence. Question as to whether we can do the same thing. Discussion of Street Light Pilot and whether we can join.
 - 2014 Energy Survey (municipal energy use) – This will be discussed in the upcoming Quarterly Meeting.
 - Community Garden partnership, solar powered pump – P. Clifford presented an analysis of what would be required to set up a solar powered pump; there was some question about the capacity from the shallow well.
