Mr. McGowan called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m.

Roll called was made and we had a Quorum.

Election of Officer:

First order of business was to fill the Vice Chairperson vacancy that

was tabled from our meeting on February 9, 2007. Laurence Ryan made a motion to elect Paul Feeney as Vice Chairperson, and Robert Zuba seconded the motion. All were in favor. William McGowan concluded that the nominations were now closed.

Our attorney, Valentino Lombardi reported that there is no need for any further hearings on the violations, and we as a Board have the facts and conclusions already in the case record, and the Board shall confine its review to the existing facts and applicable laws at the time of its initial decision.

Paul Feeney suggested that each board member review all of the data represented, make conclusions and make a list that proposes a decision, based on the information that has already been submitted to substantiate our conclusion and conclude if there is a violation/Findings of Fact.

Paul Feeney made a motion to place Starlight Communications and their attorney on our Agenda for our next Board meeting, which is April 3, 2007, pertaining to the Findings of Fact, and Laurence Ryan seconded the motion. All other Board members were in favor.

Other Business:

Review of examinations and approval of applications were made by the Board.
