Vision Data Solutions-#3569

Bob Gaj and Glenn Dusablon, Chief Elec. Investigator are sworn in.

Because the company did not receive notification we will hear testimony and reschedule the hearing for the next meeting.

Bob Gaj read the violation:

On August 29, 2008, DLT Investigator, Glenn Dusablon witness an employee of Vision Date Solutions LLC terminating data cabling at Circuit City, Garden City, Cranston, RI, Vision Data Solutions LLC is not in possession of any form of Rhode Island telecommunications license required to contract and engage in this work. Vision Data Solutions employee, Jesse Richardson is not in possession of a Rhode Island telecommunication system technician license required to perform this work and Vision Data Solutions LLC also failed to mad an application for a permit with the City of Cranston. These are violations of RIGL 5-70-2-“Practices prohibited-contracting for telecommunications work without a license”, 5-70-2-“practices prohibited-engaging in telecommunications work without a license”, 5-70-2-“practices prohibited-unlicensed technician”, and 5-70-19d-“local laws/codes-failure to obtain a permit”.

Glenn Dusablon addressed the board.

The board agreed to notify Mr. Preto, Vision Data Solutions to appear

before the board at the December meeting.
