 - ◆ “The single most successful piece has been the ability to record, track, and respond to outcomes data. On a population-level, knowledge is power.”
- ◆ Improved Professional Satisfaction
 - ◆ “The professional satisfaction now compared to [before the pilot] is through the roof”
- ◆ Overall Transformation
 - ◆ “It’s hard to believe how far we’ve come. Just the fact that so much has changed is one of the most important things

about the whole project...The project has given us both time to think outside of the box and has helped us develop a meaningful way to get out of the box and transform our practice into something new.”

CSI-RI is growing

- ◆ 5 practices in 2008

- ◆ 16 practices on October 1st.
- ◆ Future:
 - ◆ Learn and refine model with RIQI

 - ◆ Employer engagement (benefit design)
 - ◆ Employee engagement (PCP designation)

RI Coordinated Health Planning & Accountability Advisory Council

- ◆ Legislative charge (Public Law 259 Containing Amendments to Chapter 23 Section 81-4): The initial priority of the council shall be *an assessment of the needs of the state with regard to hospital services* and to present recommendations, if any, for modifications to the *Hospital Conversion Act and the Certificate of Need Program* to execute the strategic recommendations of the council. The council shall provide an initial report and recommendations to the governor and general assembly on or before March 1, 2013. The council will meet the legislative requirement outlined above by reviewing targeted analyses on how primary care infrastructure influences demand for hospital services, how demand for hospital services is distributed by community and is changing over time, and options for strategically aligning demand with supply.

Commercial Insurance: 2013 Rate Factors Review

- ◆ Health Plans filed in May of this year at historical recent lows
- ◆ Decisions to be announced on 9/20
- ◆ Four Affordability Standards maintained:
 - ◆ Primary Care Spend. Medical Home, HIT/Currentcare and Hospital Standards (last modified to promote more payment reform)
- ◆ Better monitoring of renewals for compliance
- ◆ Upward pressure on premiums will continue
