- ◦ There must be a spotter for any vehicle that is backing up**

▪ There are 22 people right now, if there is enough demand we may run another course

▪ Firefighter 2 will be offered later

▪ these are not complicated programs

◦ Revisions to rules and regs for ALS certification were passed out tonight. We never had EMS on there before.

◦ Highlights are basically for EMS

◦ Changes : new ambulance license as of July 1

▪ AB license allows ALS equipment on the truck even if it is only B service.

▪ Encouraged by state to have ALS equipment on Rescues 2 and 3 as well as car 5

▪ Officers must hold certain qualifications

▪ This must be approved by this group before it can be sent to the state

▪ very few changes to fire side

▪ Next stage will be to determine qualiifications for ALS per diem people

- per diem person will be in charge of shift**
- many calls on Jamestown are not ALS calls, ALS person will not be reequred on that type of shift**
- These people will be required to join and become a part of the organization**

▪ Ordered new vehicle to replace car 5

▪ Should we discuss this with an attorney?

- We have to follow state protocols, and this is following directly, just applying it to our local department.
- The BFW, according to bylaws, has the right to make the decision on the protocols of our department.

• These protocols need to be approved and submitted. We will have a special meeting on Sept 16 to make a decision on this.

• Problem with radios last night was due to the dispatcher

• There is also problem with buttons that need to be reset when the whistle blows and we get a second call

• The police cannot tone out manually when the button hasn't been reset.
