**A meeting of the Municipal Advisory Council on Statewide Permitting (MACSP) is held Tuesday, July 21, 2015, at 11:16 a.m., in the RI Department of Health Auditorium (Lower Level), Three Capitol Hill, Providence, RI.**

**Shawn Selleck, Project Manager, Office of Digital Excellence and Mayor Donald Grebien, MACSP Chairman, welcome everyone to a demonstration by Viewpoint Government Solutions (Viewpoint), the state approved computer software vendor for the project, of their new E-Permitting computer system.**

**In attendance are state officials from several offices, including the Office of Digital Excellence, the Office of Management and Budget, the State Fire Marshal's Office and the State Building Code Commission; city and town officials from the ten communities included in phase 1 of the project; and officials from the RI League of Cities and Towns.**

**Officials from Viewpoint note that this is a cloud-based program,**

**which can be used on any device. The public can apply for permits on-line. They demonstrate how the system works for different types of requests and how it will be administered by governmental officials.**

**After viewing how the system works, Mr. Selleck states that the State of RI will pay for the implementation of the program and the first year of maintenance. Local governments will pay for their maintenance after the first year. Municipal governments can add to the system by putting in kiosks in their city/town halls for permit applicants to use and by buying tablets with data plans for their inspectors.**

**Mr. Selleck states that they hope to show the system to the public in three months and launch the program in February 2016.**
