We are going to study the differences and make sure that we have an understanding of the differences and then make out**

**recommendations. Our next meeting will be August 2nd.**

**Re-Hab Sub-Committee – Mr. Carlson reported that they have met a couple of times and that there have been three issues that we will be meeting on regarding and understanding structural differences between our current code and the new IEBC, Mr. Davey has supplied us with a report that covers the differences. Accessibility is another that thankfully after attending that Sub-Committee meeting we understand which direction we will need to take. The last is the Energy section. We are going to try to come up with an energy section which will improve the energy requirements from the current Re-Hab Code. Once we have that we will meet with the Energy Sub-Committee and present it to them.**
