I. Welcome & Roll Call:

The meeting was called to order at 12:35 p.m. by the Chair, Chief Anthony M. Pesare.

II. Request for a waiver of the "Three Year Rule:"

Chief Pesare explained that Major Lynch is requesting a waiver under the “Three-year Rule”, subsection a. He further stated that in addition to returning as an administrator, he has been involved in law enforcement throughout the years.
