Minutes of the meeting held July 15, 2004 were reviewed. Hon Fong L. Mark, Ph.D., F.A.C.M.G., entered a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Gerald Lefebvre seconded the motion, with unanimous agreement from remaining members.
