NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT CERTIFICATION

September 11, 2012 Statewide Primary

Pursuant to R.I.G.L. 17-20-26, the Rhode Island State Board of Elections will commence certification of mail ballots for all cities and towns for the Statewide Primary being held on Tuesday, September 11, 2012. Certification will take place on the dates listed below. All certifications will take place at the Board of Elections, 50 Branch Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island.

Upon the opening of the polls on Election Day, the certified mail ballots will be given to the operator of the automated ballot counter for public processing by the automated ballot counter. Tabulation of the mail ballots will occur no earlier than 9:00 P.M. on Election Night.

Persons representing a candidate or party during the mail ballot certification process or election night counting are requested to submit this information in writing to the Board of Elections at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the certification process.

Said meetings are open meetings, and all interested parties are invited to attend. Those persons having any questions should direct them to the undersigned at 401-222-2345. Persons requiring hearing assistance or interpreter services must call this office at least 48 hours in advance of the meetings.
