**Review of old business, correspondence & subcommittee recommendations.**

**Old Business:**

**Chairman Dias shall advise the Board of the discussions that took place during the January 4, 2011 Subcommittee Meeting and shall present the Board with the following questions:**

**“Whether it wishes the subcommittee to continue to utilize the National Code as a base document for determining when certain occupancies are provided with fire alarm systems.”**

**or**

**“Whether the Board wishes the Subcommittee to utilize the existing State fire alarm code, as the base document for the installation of fire alarm systems in the covered occupancies, and, if so, should the Subcommittee review this base document with current “occupancy triggers” listed in the national codes”.**

**The Board shall have a follow-up discussion, address the above question as to when a fire alarm system should be required, and determine the appropriate course of future Subcommittee action on these specific issues.**
