Magnolia Bridge Removal

What: RIDOT will appear at a neighborhood meeting hosted by Providence City Councilwoman Sabina Matos to provide information and answer questions from the public regarding the removal of the Magnolia Bridge No. 503. This bridge, which supports eastbound U.S. Route 6 over the Plainfield Street ramps, will be taken out of service in 2013. Concurrently, the off-ramp from U.S. Route 6 West to Plainfield Street will be closed permanently.

Why: The structurally deficient Magnolia Bridge No. 503, which supports U.S. Route 6 East over the Plainfield Street ramps, will be taken out of service in order to ensure the continued safety of the motoring public. RIDOT is demolishing this bridge because of its severely deteriorating condition. The removal of the bridge will allow for a realignment of U.S. Route 6 just west of its intersection with Route 10. RIDOT also will relocate the Plainfield Street on-ramp from the left side of the highway to the right side. These improvements will improve traffic flow on U.S. Route 6 and increase safety for both highway users and motorists accessing the highway from Plainfield Street.
