As part of our continuing series of Project Informational Meetings, RIDOT will present the scope of work for the proposed improvements in the High Street & Kingstown Road (Route 108) Project. The project begins at the High Street/Main Street intersection and extends to the Kingstown Road/North Road intersection. The condition of the pavement, curbing, sidewalk and drainage system is deteriorated. Furthermore, the existing sidewalks are not compliant with the American Disabilities Act (ADA).

The scope of work includes, repaving, installing new drainage structures and pipe, replacing curbing and sidewalk, signing and striping. These improvements will provide better traveling conditions for both vehicular and pedestrian users.

South Kingstown Town Hall is located on RIPTA Bus Route 66 and is accessible to persons with disabilities. Individuals who do not speak the English language or who are hearing impaired may contact RIDOT on or before May 2, 2013 to request an interpreter.
