**SECTION I.** Article X entitled "Stopping, Standing and Parking." of Chapter 18 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of East Providence, Rhode Island, 1998, as amended, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic." Subsection 18-307 entitled "Parking prohibited at all times." is amended by deleting therefrom the following:

**GROSVENOR AVENUE (north side) from North Hull Street to North County Street during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. school days.**

**SECTION II.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its second passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Subsection 1 8-3 07 entitled "Parking prohibited at all times." is amended to read as follows:**

**OFFICE PARKWAY (south side), from a point 33 feet west of utility Pole #19, for a distance of 120 feet**

### **East Providence Guidelines for Liquor Violations**

#### **Alcohol License holders**

**1st Offense Underage Drinking (no minor) Written Warning**

**1st Offense Underage Drinking (minor 17 and under) Show cause hearing: up to \$500 per count**

**2nd Offense Underage Drinking (no minor) Show cause hearing: up to \$250 per count**

**2nd Offense Underage Drinking (minor 17 and under) Show cause hearing: up to \$1,000 per count and up to a 3 day closure**

**3rd Offense Underage Drinking (no minor) Show cause hearing: up to \$500 per count and a 5 day closure**

**3rd Offense Underage Drinking (minor 17 and under) Show cause hearing: 10 day closure or revocation**

**4th Offense Underage Drinking Up to \$1,000 per count and/or 14 day closure or revocation**

**The Board of Licenses hereby adopts the guidelines referenced above. In the event the Board departs said guidelines because of the presence of mitigating or aggravating circumstances, the Board shall state the reason for such departure on the record.**
