Chapter 184

Open a hearing on Chapter 184 an Ordinance in amendment of Section 28 Off-Street Parking, Chapter 134 of the Zoning Code of Ordinances, of the Town of Hopkinton, RI, as amended, sponsored by Councilor Cordone.

Section 28. Off-Street Parking

(A) Off-street parking facilities

(1) Any structure or use, erected or constructed after the date of passage of this ordinance, shall provide off-street parking facilities in accordance with the following minimum requirements:

(e) Retail or personal service business. One (1) parking space for every seventy-

five (75) two-hundred thirty five (235) square feet of floor area.
