

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT the Rhode Island Department of Human Services has requested the establishment of a Review Commission to consider and advise the Rhode Island Department of Human Services and the Rhode Island Department of Administration as to whether it is in the best interests of the State of Rhode Island to utilize a public labor agreement (“PLA”) for the construction of the proposed Rhode Island Veterans Home in Bristol, Rhode Island (the “Project”).

Given this, the Veterans Home Review Commission is requesting public comment from any person who has or may have an interest in the Project to provide the Project Review Commission with any documentation, studies, statistical analysis, information or the like, both in favor of or against the use of a PLA regarding the proposed Project.

TO HEAR TESTIMONY CONCERNING THE POSSIBLE IMPLEMENTATION OF A PLA FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT.
