Consider Changes to the Unclassified Service Classification and Pay Plan

On Tuesday, June 3, 2014 at 8:15 A.M. in Conference Room C, Second Floor, William E. Powers Building (Department of Administration), One Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island 02908-5890, the Director of the Department of Administration, Richard A. Licht will hold a public hearing in accordance with the provisions of Sections 36-4-16 and 36-4-16.2 of the General Laws of 1956, as amended, to consider revisions to the Unclassified Service Classification and Pay Plan. The changes are:

- 2.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, April 6, 2014; 2.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, October 5, 2014; 2.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, October 4, 2015 for eligible**

unclassified service organized employees as a result of negotiated wage settlements due to collective bargaining between the State of Rhode Island and the:

- RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO**
- Laborers' International Union of North America – RI Laborers' District Council (LIUNA)**
- Howard Union of Teachers, A.F.T., Local 1171, AFL-CIO including fifty-two (52) week employees and one hundred eighty (180) day employees**

*** Note: Implementation of the above identified general salary increases is dependent upon union ratification of all negotiated terms and conditions including formal written notice of such by each union to the State.**

• 2.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, April 6, 2014; 2.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, October 5, 2014; 2.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, October 4, 2015 for eligible unclassified service non-organized employees including eligible unclassified service non-organized employees of the Office of the Governor.
