Notice of Public Hearing

Consider Changes to the Unclassified Service Classification and Pay Plan

On Monday, July 7, 2014 at 8:00 A.M. in Conference Room C, Second Floor, William E. Powers Building (Department of Administration), One Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island 02908-5890, the Director of the Department of Administration, Richard A. Licht will hold a public hearing in accordance with the provisions of Sections 36-4-16 and 36-4-16.2 of the General Laws of 1956, as amended, to consider revisions to the Unclassified Service Classification and Pay Plan. The changes are:

- Agenda Item # 1: classification of “Deputy Sheriff - Major” (class code: 00184300) moving from Salary Schedule 600A (Council 94) pay grade G-631A (\$60,010 - \$83,476) to Salary Schedule 800A (nonunion)**

pay grade G-835A (\$74,136 - \$84,051) in a nonstandard work week effective Sunday, June 29, 2014. There is no incumbent in this classification. This classification will be moving from a bargaining unit to nonunion status.

- **Agenda Item #2: change in title and base salary adjustment for current title “Commissioner of Board of Governors for Higher Education” (class code: 00839300) from current pay grade F-0054 (flat rate) with a flat base rate of \$134,639 to a new title “Commissioner of Postsecondary Education” (class code: 00839300) pay grade F-0054 (flat rate) with a flat base rate of \$175,000 in a nonstandard work week effective Sunday, June 29, 2014.**

- **Agenda Item #3: 3.0% general salary increase effective Sunday, February 9, 2014 for eligible unclassified service nonunion/non-organized Commissioned Officers of the RI State Police within the classifications of: “Lieutenant (State Police)”, “Captain (State Police)”, “Major (State Police)”, and “Lieutenant Colonel (State Police)”. The Cabinet level classification of “Superintendent – Director of Public Safety/Commissioner” does not qualify.**

It is the purpose of this hearing to invite comment from all parties on the proposed changes in the unclassified service classification and pay plan as identified above.
