Richard Bunjiro, PhD


Dr. Bunjiro received his BA in Biology from Johns Hopkins in 1992 and PhD in Pathobiology from Brown University in 1999. As a graduate student he worked with Paul Knopf on immune responses to the parasitic blood fluke *Schistosoma mansoni*. He served as a teaching assistant for multiple courses, receiving the *Eleonore Way Presidential Award for Excellence in Teaching* in 1997. After completing his graduate work he instructed BIOL 0530 (Principles of Immunology) and BIOL 0540 (Biology of Emerging Microbial Diseases, now BIOL 1550). Following his teachings, he joined the research group of Michael Cappello '84 at the Yale University School of Medicine where he worked on blood feeding hookworms. In 2008 he returned to Brown as a faculty member in the Department of Molecular Microbiology and Immunology. As a Lecturer in Biology he taught BIOL 0530, BIOL 1600 (Development of Vaccines to Infectious Diseases), BIOL 1550, and the laboratory for BIOL 0510 (Introductory Microbiology). He serves as a first-year advisor, Randall sophomore advisor, and concentration advisor for Biology programs. Dr. Bunjiro has been honored by the Senior classes of 2010 and 2012 with the *Barrett Hazeltine Citation* and in 2011 received the *Dean's Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching, Advising, and Mentoring*.
