**he played an important role in several NCI-funded population cancer research studies. In addition, as part of his role at Ohio State, he served as a liaison to the Ohio Department of Health and the local division of the**

**American Cancer Society. During that time, Dr. McLaughlin also served as a consulting epidemiologist for**

**Informagenics, LLC, a Columbus-based contract research organization that provided data analytic and health outcomes research support to several large pharmaceutical companies. Dr. McLaughlin received a B.A. in**

**Zoology from Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, and a M.S. and Ph.D. in Epidemiology from The Ohio State University College of Public**
