ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 3 ANIMALS AND FOWL (1st reading)

ARTICLE I

SECTION 3-5 Animals at large.

No cattle, sheep, goats, swine, horses, rabbits and domestic fowl shall be at large, loose or unfastened in any public street or highway or elsewhere in the town, and every owner of any such animal found at large shall be guilty of a violation of this chapter.

SECTION 3-6 Registration of Animals

Registration of bovine, horses, livestock, rabbits and domestic fowl required.

The owner, harbinger and/or keeper of any cattle, sheep, goats, swine, horses, rabbits and domestic fowl housed, kept or boarded within the town must register with the town police department/division of animal control. Registration information must include the name, address and phone number of the owner, emergency contact name and phone number location where the animals are housed and the number of, and type of, animals kept.

SECTION 3-7 Cleanliness and Sanitation of premises where animals and fowl kept.

The owner or person in control of any building or premises in which cows, goats, sheep, swine, poultry, horses and/or rabbits are maintained shall keep the building and premises clean and free from decaying food, dirt, water and fecal matter. Buildings and pens shall be whitewashed and disinfected and put in such sanitary conditions as may be ordered by the animal control officer.

SECTION 3-8 Feeding of birds, domestic animals.

(a) No person shall place food in the open for the feeding of any domesticated fowl, bird or animal, except in such containers as will prevent the scattering of such food upon the ground. After such feeding, such food shall not be allowed where it is accessible to rats.

(b) No person shall feed wild birds other than in suitable containers for the food, elevated at least 48 inches above the ground level.

SECTION 3-9 Feeding of wildlife.

No person shall feed, or place food or refuse in such a manner as to cause a food source for any wild animal.
