Mr. Brian Remy will be on vacation when the bids are to be opened so someone from the treatment plant will go to the town hall on the day the bids are opened and bring them to Mr. Dave Johnson and both Mr. Johnson and Mr. Costa will review the bids and make a decision on who will be awarded the bid.

contract for the Asylum Road Pump Station.

Mr. Ernie Mayo contacted Mr. Dave Johnson regarding the school dept. project. Mr. Johnson notified Mr. Mayo that a set of plans is needed to be reviewed prior to any work being done. Once the plans are reviewed than a decision will be made on the next step.

A memo from Mr. Michael Abruzzi regarding the capital budget. Brian Remy will be on vacation so the capital budget will not be ready by 1/3/06. At the next Sewer Commission meeting, which will be 1/10/06, a discussion will be made regarding capital monies.

J & K Sanitation presents the commission with a bill for \$2550.00 for Main Street Pumping Station. He charged per gallon the same as he does for the town residents. The commission would like Steve from J & K to come up with an hourly rate for jobs that are above and beyond the town resident jobs. The commission votes to pay Steve \$125.00 per hour for the man and truck. Steve agrees to charge the commission \$1000.00 for the job and will charge \$125.00 per hour for outside jobs.
