

## **Minutes for June 13, 2006**

**Mike Schrader begins the meeting by opening the bids for contract #3 Sewer Rehabiliatation. Three bids were received Nepco, National Water Main & Allstate Power Vac. The lowest bidder was Allstate Power Vac. Mike will review each bid and make a recommendation for the commission. All three bids were close. Mike states he met with Jay Manning (RIDEM) today regarding this project because there was some confusion on his part he thought the permitting was done previously but Mike tells him that was not this project so he will issue new permits which will take approximately 30 days which will be fine anyway because it wall take that long to issue the job. Mike says he will have to apply for an extension of this job December 31, 2006 he says approximately 60 % will be done so there should be no problem in getting the extension.**

**Asylum Road Pump Station needs to be addressed regarding the**

extension of the Hugh Cole School a special meeting on June 27th will be held at 6:00 PM at 427 Water Street regarding these issues the Bristol Warren Regional School dept. will be invited to attend to discuss this issue. Also, the sewer connection for this project was already complete without any sewer permits or road cut permits. Brian Remy went by Asylum Road and noticed the road cut. He opened the manhole to find they had already connected so he also wants to find out who connected the extension and hold them responsible.

DEM sent a letter to Mike Shrader regarding the Samsonite Building on Main Street. Mike had a meeting with Warren Towne & Jay Manning from DEM regarding different issues. First they would like to know the approximate flow that this project would have a complete survey of the building to make sure no illegal connections for example roof leaders tied into the system or catch basins. DEM also made a suggestion regarding installing permanent flow meters into the system to get some data. Brian says he had spoke to one of the gentleman regarding this project and approximately 300 units is what they are proposing but to date nothing is in black & white. Brian is concerned about if the North Pump Station will be able to handle that flow also the line that is running down Water Street. John Costa makes a motion to send a copy of the letter from Dem to the sewer dept. regarding the issues they have for the samsonite building to the planning board. Brian Remy seconds it. Mike asks the commission for a copy of the charter he has never received one.

**Motion make to award the contract #3 sewer rehabilitation project to Allstate Vac. Company providing they meet the specs and all references check out. Motion makde by Brian Remy and Dave Johnson seconds it.**

**Brian tells the commission of a property owner in Warren that is now building a new home on the Warren/Swansea line. He is requesting to tie into the Warren sewer system he is approximately 5 feet from the manhole. John Costa wants to know where he is paying his property taxes and if he is paying Swansea taxes then he needs to connect into Swansea.**
