Mike Schrader presents the commission with contract # 3 which will begin on Wednesday September 20, 2006 on Union Street. The DPW are paving several streets so the contractor will coordinate with them as far as what streets will be worked on. Woodard & Curran will have a subcontractor that will observe sewer replacement on a full time basis and rehabilitation work on a part time basis. Also, Ann Morrill spoke to Mike regarding filling out paper work for a grant in order to have some areas in Town camerad. She would also like to have some storm drains camerad.

Asylum Road Pump Station the commission is considering a direct design and build approach. Woodard & Curran contacted DEM to discuss the pump station upgrade they had no problem with it. DEM

only requests that the commission review the design with the Town Manager.

Capacity Management Program the Town Council is reviewing the draft and a workshop will have to be held with the Town Council and Town Manager.

Facility Plan Update is still awaiting for the results of the Touisset needs assessment so this work can be completed.

Samsonite Mill Project Mr. Tony DeSisto has requested that the proposal be reworked to be a peer review only. Brian would like Mike to work with there inspectors when they are going through that building to make sure that everthing is checked nothing is overlooked as far as what is entering the sewer system is concerned.

New Vactor truck has arrived Brian tells the commission that the truck was in the garage and only the front end sticks out a little so only an outside door would have to be installed.
