

## **Minutes from October 10, 2006**

### **Warren Sewer Commission**

**Mike presents the commission with a list of issues regarding the Contract #3 status. First issue is the dig and replace sub contractor who cut an active gas line and also did damage to the parking lot in fire station on Water street. Allstate Power Vac fired them and CB Utilities will finish the work. Fiore Construction, which was the sub contractor, is requesting a meeting with the commission. Brian Remy states he had received a call from St. Mary of the BayChurch this morning because Fiore also parked their equipment in the church parking lot without permission and the priest of the church would like that removed by Saturday because of mass on Sunday. Brian makes a motion to place a call to Fiore to remove the equipment and that the commission at this point has no reason to speak to Fiore. John Costa and Dave Johnson seconds it. Brian Remy asks Mike exactly what each contractor is actually doing. Mike explains that NEPCO will be doing the manholes and Allstate will be doing the joints in the pipe. Brian makes a recommendation that from now on he would like**

to divide the bids so each contractor would bid only on a specific job instead of one contractor bidding on the whole job and sub the work out. Mike explains that some contractors won't bid on the job if it is broke up that way because it isn't enough money to bid.

Capacity Management plan Mike has nothing to add or the Facility Plan Update Mike asks Brian to call Mr. Mike Abruzzi on these issues to see if there are any updates.

The Warren Town Beach Mike presents the commission with a letter regarding this issue. The letter states to this point what work has been done there. Inland Water sent an proposal that they will camera that 24 inch line on night to see if that line is cracked or broken to find out where the problem is. Brian would like Mike to come up with a price of what it will cost to replace that whole line from Bridge Street to the head of the plant. He also would like to get rid of the five manholes on Bridge Street and only leave one. Mike asks the commission about just lining the pipe. The commission makes a motion to get two proposals one to replace the line and one to line the pipe.

Mike gives the commission an update on teh i & l he says out of the illegal connections that were found some were fixed. Mike suggests that to go back to check the ones that have not been fixed and if to date have not been fixed suggest fining these residents per day until they are fixed.

**List of drain layers were presented to the Warren Sewer Commission for approval for year 2007.**

**Bids for the garage door will be open on October 16th at the Town Hall and also the bid will be going out for the Asylu Road Pump Station. Dave Komiega asks the commission what they want to be done regarding Inland Waters cameraing that line in front of the beach. Brian says that that work is going through the town manager so for Dave to call them to set up arrangements as far as time and date and then the bill is to go right to the town hall.**
