

## **Minutes for March 13, 2007**

**Dave Komiega presents the commission with a proposal from New England Gas Company to run a gas line to the Asylum Road Pump Station to run the generator. Dave Johnson wants to know when the gas company will be doing the job. Dave Komiega tells him that the job will be started as soon as the gas company receives the check. Mike Schrader explains usually the contractor who is doing the job will pay for all of the expenses and add it to his scope of work. Because this is SRF monies it is easier for the contractor to pay and bill all together. Mr. Johnson questions the money that is owed from the contractor who connected the sewer line on Asylum Road without the proper paper work. Dave Komiega explains that he has sent two letters to the Bristol Warren Regional School Dept. fining the contractor who has written back stating the dates which was from June to September was not right and so no fine should be assessed. The commission would like another letter sent to the school dept. regarding this issue.**

**Kate Federoff lawyer for the Warren Sewer Commission contacted Mr. Komiega regarding the Bristol County Water Authority. She told David that she has not hired an arbitrator yet to go through the paperwork to make a decision regarding the back fines and monthly fees from the Water Company. Regarding the invoice the commission would like to send a copy to Mr. Mike Abbruzzi so he will know what is owed.**

**Dave Komiega discusses the capital accounts that was presented to Mr. Michael Abbruzzi and now will be presented to the Warren Town Council. Mike Schrader has a few questions regarding some of the accounts and what they included.**

**Dave Komiega hands the February highlights for the commission to review.**

**John Costa asks Mike Schrader about the facility plan. Mike presents the draft he says a few more things is needed to complete this project for example checking out the major pump stations in town. He explains that after the pump stations are done the commission will receive a draft for review along with RIDEM.**

**Capacity management program Mike received it back from the lawyers who added their comments now Mike needs to respond to them. That will be put on the Town Council agenda, which will go through the first reading, second reading etc.**

**Regarding the Samsonite project at this point we are waiting for them to present some kind of plan in order to see what they are proposing as far as the sewer work is concerned. We will need to know flows, which way they are sending the flow directly to the pump station or through the parking lot and up Sission Street.**
