### **Meeting begins 6:00 PM**

**Brian Remy brings the meeting to order. He explains the reason he has called this meeting together. He would like all parties involved in the illegal sewer connection that occurred on Asylum Road for the connection of the Hugh Cole School to try to resolve the problem. The fine was sent to the Bristol Warren School dept. the school dept. sent the fine to Lucy Construction who was the general contractor on the job and then they sent the fine to A. Korey construction who was the sub-contractor. A. Korey says they feel it is unfair the size of the fine but know it was done without the proper paperwork and are willing to pay some type of fine but not \$9500. Brian Remy explains that the fines are based on the sewer ordinance and if the town does not fine for this type of infraction that DEM will fine the town. The question that A.Korey would like to have answered is the sewer**

ordinance states that 100.00 per day for illegal discharge and from June to September there was no discharge in that line. So they are asking to lower the fine from \$9500 to \$500. Brian says that he would have to get in touch with Mike Schrader (woodard & Curran) engineering to find out what the next step would be. He tells everyone the sewer commission can only set the fine but can't decrease it without getting approval first.
