2. Application of Barbara Jackson and Rollin Whyte to remove an existing door and replace with a window and clapboards on the northwest corner of the existing structure on the property located at 50 Pleasant Street being AP 117, lot 100 located in a Village Residential Historic District.

3. Application of Jim Jensen to install a new front porch light fixture and replace an existing patio with a deck on the existing single family dwelling on the property located at 41 Main Street being AP 117, lot 224 located in a Village Residential Historic District.
