In that on June 10, 2006 Officer Larivee responded to the Sandbar & Grill, 885 Oakland Beach Ave. for a liquor law check. Officer Larivee entered the establishment and noticed five patrons at the bar, a couple of patrons had drinks in their hands and the others had drinks in front of them. The drinks included an Amstel Light and various mixed drinks. Officer Larivee made contact with a subject that was walking out from behind the bar, identified as Richard Spicuzza. Mr. Spicuzza identified himself as the manager of the bar. Officer Larivee advised Mr. Spicuzza that it was approximately quarter to two and notified him that patrons needed to be out of the bar by 1:30 a.m. He stated that he knew and apologized and stated that he lost track of time. Officer Larivee was then joined at the bar by Sgt. Gilbert. Sgt. Gilbert had advised Officer Larivee earlier that he had already given the bar a warning approximately one week earlier. At that time, he advised Mr. Spicuzza about the liquor laws. Mr. Spicuzza was then notified that he would be receiving a violation for allowing patrons to consume alcohol after hours and remain in the establishment after hours.

Due to the aforementioned facts, the management of, Sandbar & Grill, 885 Oakland Beach Ave., Warwick is in violation of the following rules

and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.

Article #9 Clearance of Premises and Associated Areas:

A. All patrons shall leave the licensed premises within one-half hour after the required closing time, and all employees shall leave the licensed premises within one hour after the required closing time, and all employees and patrons shall leave the associated parking and outside areas within one hour after the required closing time.

**C. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed by the licensee or employees after
the required closing time.**
