**LICENSES AND PERMITS**

**3. Eddies 529**

**In that on 10/19/09 at approximately 2:10 a.m. Officer Andrews was on**

**routine patrol when he passed Eddy's 529, 529 Warwick Avenue when he observed the lights of the establishment being on. Officer Andrews exited his vehicle and walked up to the front door where he observed four males and a female at the bar. After knocking on the door a female identified as Erin Harris answered the door. The female identified herself as the bartender and said she was counting out the drawer and her tips and was closing up. The officer asked who the other individuals in the bar were. Ms. Harris then told the officer that the only person there was a friend who helps her with the trash at the end of the night. Officer Andrews had seen three other individuals who probably went out the back door as he was knocking on the front door. She stated that she was unaware of the liquor law requiring that she needed to call into police headquarters for an extension. Since she is a fairly new bartender, the officer advised her that she is required to call in to request permission to be in the establishment after the 2:00 a.m. cutoff time if she feels it will be necessary. **Officer Andrews violated Eddy's for being open after hours, having persons present in the bar after hours. The bartender was made aware of this violation.**

**Due to the aforementioned facts the management of Eddy's 529, 529 Warwick Avenue is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.**

## **1. CLEARANCE OF PREMISES AND ASSOCIATED AREAS:**

**A. All patrons shall leave the licensed premises within one-half hour after the required closing time, and all employees shall leave the licensed premises within one hour after the required closing time, and all employees and patrons shall leave the associated parking and outside areas within one hour after the required closing time.**

**B. In the event of extenuating circumstances, the licensee may request an extension from the commanding officer on duty of the Warwick Police Department. Such an extension, if granted, shall be for a specified time.**

**D. No one, other than employees, police and enforcement personnel, shall be admitted to the premises after the required closing time.**

**4. Rosie's Lounge**

**(1) In that on November 22, 2009 at approximately 0134 hours, Detective McAniff and Officer Michel were dispatched to a liquor law check at Rosie's Lounge, 731 Airport Road. Upon arrival the officers observed eight vehicles in the parking lot of the establishment. Detective McAniff spoke with the owner Mr. Bowen who stated the only people in the building were the workers and the band that was packing up their musical equipment. Mr. Bowen indicated he hadn't called for an extension yet and that he normally does if the workers haven't left the building by 0200 hours. At that time Mr. Bowen dialed headquarters and spoke with the officer in charge and was granted an extension. and given a verbal warning.**

**(2) At approximately 0149 hours Officer Bulis called out with a car stop in the area of Post Road at Sandlewood with a female who had been involved in an altercation at the establishment. It was determined that the female had been involved in a physical altercation with another female in the front lot shortly before the liquor law check had been conducted. Officer Bulis advised the detective that the female at this motor vehicle stop stated that there were many workers that saw the incident which happened in front of the establishment in the parking lot. She also stated that the incident was never reported to the police.**

**Due to the aforementioned facts the management of Rosie's Lounge,**

**731 Airport Road, Warwick, is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.**

**C. All patrons shall leave the licensed premises within one-half hour after the required closing time, and all employees shall leave the licensed premises within one hour after the required closing time, and all employees and patrons shall leave the associated parking and outside areas within one hour after the required closing time.**
