LICENSES AND PERMITS

3. On the Dock Grill

(1) The continuation of live entertainment (“open mike” Tuesday 9/14/10) without a license.

Due to the aforementioned facts the management of On the Dock Grill, 50 Waterfront Drive, Warwick, is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.

15. LIVE ENTERTAINMENT Live Entertainment shall not be permitted on any licensed premises without a valid license for the same having first been issued by the Board of Public Safety. Live Entertainment shall include shows, bands, disc jockeys, and other forms of entertainment other than a juke box. Amended 7/24/07

ACTION:

(2) On 9/18/10 at approximately 0044 hours, Officer Francis responded to On the Dock Grill, 52 Waterfront Drive for a Liquor Law check of this establishment. It was brought to Officer Francis attention that this establishment was going through a liquor law process through the City of Warwick. On this date the establishment was not permitted to have live entertainment. Officer Francis observed loud music to be playing and approximately 12 patrons inside the establishment. Officer Francis observed what appeared to be a DJ music stereo along with numerous CD’s. The system was on

and music was playing which could be heard from over 100 feet away.

There was a male subject at the table who appeared to be operating this equipment. Officer Francis observed several patrons dancing inside the bar.

Officer Francis made contact with the owner David Eceleston who was present at the scene and advised him of the discrepancy. Mr. Eceleston became defensive stating he had proper licensing and felt he was being targeted by the Warwick Police Department. Officer Francis explained that there were random liquor checks being performed on this date throughout the City. Officer Francis requested to see the alleged proper license for Live Entertainment; however Mr. Eceleston continued to be defensive and never came forward with the license. Officer Francis walked to his vehicle and upon return to the establishment noted the music was shut off and the stereo equipment was neatly stacked away. Mr. Eceleston stated to Officer Francis that there were no violations at the bar and that the DJ's are considered

"live entertainment". Officer Francis then explained to the owner that DJ's are considered "live entertainment" and because of this he would be violated and a report would be filed. Mr. Eceleston appeared highly upset after this and asked Officer Francis what he should do next. Officer Francis advised him that he would need to have them clear out, indicating the DJ and the equipment. At this point all of the patrons left the bar and the bar staff began to clean up, the time was approximately 0055 hours. (10-4242 OF)

4. Village Corner Tavern

(1) In that on August 13, 2010 at 0126 hours Officer Marano was dispatched to the Village Corner Tavern, 941 West Shore Road for a report of male parties still in the bar drinking and doing drugs. Officer Marano was previously there doing a liquor law check when he asked everybody to leave so that the bartender could start cleaning up for the night. Officer Marano told the four or five patrons who were in there that if they didn't work there, they had to leave. Officer Marano then went back out to his car and the above patrons

exited out the back and front door. Shortly thereafter, Officer Marano got another call for service before coming back to the Village Corner Tavern. Upon his return Sergeant Snow, Sergeant Read and Officer Larivee were already on the scene. Sergeant Snow then advised Officer Marano that he had witnessed two patrons still to be in the bar after 1:30. Sergeant Read was out there previously on a call a few days ago and warned the manager at the time for this same type of violation. (OF 3592 OF)

Due to the aforementioned facts the management of Village Corner Tavern, 941 West Shore Road, Warwick, is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.

9. CLEARANCE OF PREMISES AND ASSOCIATED AREAS:

A. All patrons shall leave the licensed premises within one-half hour after the required closing time, and all employees shall leave the licensed premises within one hour after the required closing time, and all employees and patrons shall leave the associated parking and outside areas within one hour after the required closing time.

(2) The purpose of said appearance is to show that Village Corner Tavern has been in compliance with the Rules and Regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety. Failure to appear will result in immediate suspension of your liquor license.

(3) On September 13, 2010 at approximately 2317 hours Officer Fernandes responded to the Village Corner Tavern (call number 10-51926) for the report of a disturbance of the peace. Officer Fernandes heard loud noise from the parking lot across Winter Avenue emanating from the establishment. Upon entering the establishment Officer Fernandes observed a karaoke type machine with a patron singing into a microphone.

On September 23, 2010 at approximately 0002 hours Officer Fernandes conducted a liquor law check at the above establishment and advised the bartender, that the bar would be cited for conducting live entertainment without being licensed for such activities. The bartender stated she would advise the owner.

Due to the aforementioned facts the management of Village Corner Tavern, 941 West Shore Road, Warwick, is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments. (10-4348 OF)

15. LIVE ENTERTAINMENT Live Entertainment shall not be permitted on any licensed premises without a valid license for the same having first been issued by the Board of Public Safety. Live Entertainment shall include shows, bands, disc jockeys, and other forms of entertainment other than a juke box. Amended 7/24/07
