### **4. McKinley's Foot of the Hill Tavern**

**In that on February 5, 2011 at approximately 0027 Sergeant Snow was dispatched to the parking lot of McKinley's Tavern, 1 Division Street regarding an accident involving a drunk driver. Upon arrival Sergeant Snow met with Officers Morretti and Myer who advised of the circumstances of the incident and it was determined that the female would be arrested.**

**After completing this task Sergeant Snow decided to do a liquor**

**check at McKinley's as the bar appeared extremely busy. Upon entering the bar it was estimated that approximately 200 to 250 people were inside the establishment. Upon checking the liquor license (BV 120) and the capacity of the bar it was found that the maximum allowed was 100 people. At this point the door men were advised that they were over capacity and no-one else would be allowed inside. A quick head count by myself and Officer Morretti discovered that 150 people were inside far exceeding the capacity limit. At this point the bar manager was advised that there were 50 people over the capacity and that 50 people would have to leave. Due to the upcoming closing time numerous groups of people left prior to us securing a second head count.**

**Due to the aforementioned facts, the management of, McKinley's Foot of the Hill Tavern, 1 Division Street, East Greenwich, is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.**

**12. PATRON CAPACITY: No licensed establishment shall allow occupancy of the licensed premises to exceed that allowed under applicable fire and safety codes. In addition, the Board of Public Safety may, from time to time, establish a lesser maximum occupancy at designated licensed premises.**
