5. Biki's Bar and Grill

On 4/13/12 at approximately 0221 hours Officers Fernandes, Andrews and Waddington were dispatched to Biki's Bar and Grill for the report of a driver who was passed out behind the wheel of a car that was in the parking lot. Upon arrival Officer Fernandes noticed the car in the parking lot, vehicle not running. The male was passed out and there was a female in the front passenger seat who had the passenger side door ajar. The female was awake and was able to speak with the Officers. Officer Fernandes questioned both as to where they had been for the evening and they stated they had been together but did not know where they had been. Officer Fernandes was able to contact a family member to come and take custody of the two for the night.

Officers Waddington and Andrews responded into the bar and observed that there were still people in the bar. Officers Waddington and Andrews made contact with the owner of the bar Debra Vita and several people who were identified as employees of the bar. Ms. Vita stated to the officer that she had lost track of time. Ms. Vita was asked if she had called for an extension she stated she had not known what time it was. Ms. Vita seemed surprised when she was given the time, she stated she had had some band issues and they had been discussing how they could remedy the situation.

Officer Fernandes and Sergeant Choquette explained to Ms. Vita that

they were in violation of the liquor law statute that all patrons had to be off the grounds by 0130 hours and all employees had to be off the grounds by 0200 hours. Ms. Vita stated that she understood. All employees left the premises, the premises was secured and the alarm was set by Ms. Vita.

Due to the aforementioned facts the management of Biki's Bar and Grill is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.

1. CLEARANCE OF PREMISES AND ASSOCIATED AREAS:

A. All patrons shall leave the licensed premises within one-half hour after the required closing time, and all employees shall leave the licensed premises within one hour after the required closing time, and all employees and patrons shall leave the associated parking and outside areas within one hour after the required closing time.

B. In the event of extenuating circumstances, the licensee may request an extension from the commanding officer on duty of the Warwick Police Department. Such an extension, if granted, shall be for a specified time.
