**3. Shannon View Inn (Noise Violation/Complaints) – September 27, 2013 (Continuation)**

**“On Friday, September 27, 2013 at 1942 hours, I (Officer Steven Nelson) was dispatched to 24 Elkland Road for a report of very loud music and I spoke with Sharon Lupo. The music was coming from the rear of 1901 Post Road. The Shannon View Inn was having a band, in an open tent, on the back of the property of 1901 Post Road. I could hear the music noticeably**

**loud from the front porch of 24 Elkland Road. I was invited inside and at that time the band took a break (stopped playing) and the noise level from the tent subsided to a quieter level.**

**I waited a few minutes for the noise meter to be dropped off at my location. I calibrated the meter and then started to take readings from the rear of the property line of 24 Elkland Road; the band was playing at this time and was noticeably loud. As I was taking readings, other noise complaints came in to WPD dispatch.**

**The readings from the rear of 24 Elkland Road were recorded in Call #13-53146:**

**The meter was taken at the rear property line of 24 Elkland. Noise levels taken with the band playing. It should be noted that the readings were taken when other ambient noise was low.**

**1st reading 71.4 dba – 78.9 db 2021 hours**

**2nd reading 71.7 dba – 75.2 db 2029 hours**

**3rd reading 72.3 dba – 74.9 db 2037 hours**

**71.8 dba is the average of the lowest reading. Well over the 60 dba limit between 8a.m. – 10 p.m.**

**I responded over and advised the owner/manager, Mr. David Miller, of the infraction and he stopped the band soon after. I also advised Sgt. Kelly of the results.**

**On October 2, 2013, I stopped at Shannon View Inn and issued the business a municipal violation #21277 for NOISE (Warwick Ord. 40-13). Mr. David Miller was not at the business but was called on the phone and notified of the violation. I advised Miller that I would have the Bartender sign for the violation. I had Elizabeth Grey, Shannon View employee, sign the violation.**

**Ms. Grey signed and printed her name. The violation is a pay by mail and a court date of November 21, 2013 at 6 p.m. was given.**

**Shannon View Inn (Liquor License Violation) – October 12, 2013**

**On October 12, 2013 Officer Keri Leighton was performing a liquor law check at 2:12 a.m. at the Shannon View Inn and found three employees inside the establishment after hours.**

**Due to the aforementioned facts, the management of the Shannon View Inn is in violation of the following rules and regulations issued by the Board of Public Safety for the orderly operation of liquor establishments.**
