5. Save Bristol Harbor Presentation - Water Quality/Predictive Habitat Model Update – Joe Arruda, Bob Aldrich and Keith Maloney.

6. Harbor Management Plan Update – Harbor Management Plan Approved by CRMC with five (5) required elements to be completed by 2/15/13 as follows:

1) Mooring feet coordinate data must be recorded in Rhode Island Plane Feet

2) Area data (acreage/square feet must be recorded for each mooring field

3) ACOE “Open to All” policy must be included

4) Intertidal flats must be inventoried or mentioned as absent

5) Harbor ordinance must include a provision that requires all moored vessels

to remain within their mooring field perimeters when attached to mooring gear

7. Rockwell Transient Docks – Dave M, Scott M, Jim D and Matt Calouro committee to meet in April to finalize sign plan and to draft rules and fees for these transient docks. Jim D met with BDMA Association to obtain current

business contact data for sign and arrange for a supply of hand out sheets to

make available to transient boaters or be put in a waterproof box for their pick-up.

Diane W to set up ribbon cutting ceremony in spring when docks are back in the Water.

8. Clipper Way ROW Court Action – summary judgment request by neighbors and Town have been both been filed.

9. State St. Dock Upgrade Committee – approx 45% complete and progress continues. Committee to schedule Phase II meeting shortly.
