**Competitive Telecommunications Service Providers: Review of the tariff revisions and a request to rescind filed by the following companies:**

**4288 – Office of Energy Resources – Review of the record and rule whether to reconsider the Commission’s October 4, 2012 decision to approve the Rhode Island Energy Resources’ (“OER”) Motion for Relief from Order No. 20676. This docket is on the Open Meeting**

**agenda in the event a bench decision is not rendered at the October 23, 2012 hearing.**

**3476 – National Grid Gas - Review and rule on National Grid’s October 1, 2012 filing seeking approval an Agreement to Modify Performance Benchmarks to the Company existing Service Quality Plan. The Agreement is executed between National Grid and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers. The Settlement proposes fixed threshold and benchmark goals for the After Business Hours Emergency Response category and implements a return to the Division’s Gas Standards’ meter accuracy inspection schedule for the Meter Testing metric.**

**4338 – National Grid Electric - Review of the record and rule on National Grid’s October 5, 2012 revised tariffs R.I.P.U.C No. 2127, Long-Term Contracting for Renewable Energy Provision (LTCRER) and R.I.P.U.C. No. 2125, LTCRER Reconciliation Provision, both of which would supersede the Company’s existing LTCRER, R.I.P.U.C. No. 2081.**

**4320 – Woonsocket Water Division – Review of the record and rule on the October 11, 2012 Settlement Agreement executed between Woonsocket Water and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers. The Settlement requests approval of new rates designed to generate additional operating revenues of \$508,381 or 6.79% over current rates, to support total operating revenue requirement of \$7,997,009.**

**4364 – Narragansett Bay Commission (NBC) – Suspension of proposed rates contained in Narragansett Bay Commission’s October 5, 2012 rate application seeking additional revenues of approximately \$12.4 million for 14.5% to support total revenue requirement of \$98,568,187.**
