4396 – Verizon Rhode Island – Review and rule on the interconnection agreement between Verizon New England, Ind. d/b/a Verizon Rhode Island and 365 Wireless, LLC.

4315 – National Grid – Review and rule on National Grid’s February 22, 2013 proposed Standard Offer Service (SOS) Rates for the Industrial Group for the period April 2013 - June 2013. If approved, review and rule on National Grid’s Tariff No. 2096 (compliance tariffs).

4243 – Newport Water Division - Review of the record and rule on Newport Water’s December 28, 2012 Compliance Filing to implement the second phase of the Newport’s multi-year rate increase authorized by this docket, in Order No. 20636. The Second Phase will provide Newport Water additional revenues of \$2,145,647 to meet debt service requirements.

Discussion to open a docket pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 39-26-6(d) to determine the adequacy or potential adequacy, of renewable energy supplies to meet the increase in the percentage requirement of energy from renewable energy resources to go into effect in 2015.
