**Review and rule on the following companies request to re-certify its application to modify the percentage of New and Existing generation allocation:**

**4414 - ACP Land LLC (APC) - Review and rule on APC's application for certification for the ACP Solar I Generation Unit, a 0.49 MW Solar Energy Generation Unit located in Middletown, RI, as an eligible New Renewable Energy Resource.**

**4201 - Rhode Island LFG Genco, LLC (LFG Genco) Renewable Energy Resource Application - Review and Rule on LFG Genco's request that the Commission find that Order No. 20225 (issued on December 20, 2010) was effective as if there were no conditions contained in the Order and not on June 1, 2013, the month in which the Commission issued the unique certification number following the submission on June 11, 2013 by LFG Genco of the Commercial Operation Date (5/31/13) and NEPOOL GIS Asset Number as required by the December 20, 2010 Order.**

**Docket No. 3798 - Rules and Regulations Governing the Implementation of a Renewable Energy Standard - Review of Commission policy regarding the effective date of eligibility for Renewable Energy Resources certified by the Commission. Current Commission policy (since 2007) is that Certification of an Eligible Renewable Energy Resource is complete upon the issuance of a unique Rhode Island certification number by the Commission. It is effective on the first day of the month in which the certification number is issued. The unique Rhode Island certification number is contained in the Commission's Order for a facility that has achieved commercial operation prior to the issuance of the Commission's Order. For a facility that has not yet achieved commercial operation at the time of the Commission's Order, the unique certification number is contained in a letter to the Applicant after receipt by the**

**Commission of the Commercial Operation Date and NEPOOL GIS Asset number as required by the Commission's Order for that facility.**

**Should the Commission issue a 30-day Notice to Solicit Comments to consider changing its policy to allow a Generation Unit which otherwise qualifies as an Eligible Renewable Energy Resource to claim that eligibility for the earliest trading period still open at the time the Commission issues its Order or the Generation Unit begins delivering energy to ISO-NE, whichever is later?**
