- 2. Receive and discuss pre-hearing memo submitted by Ms. Maria Vallee's legal counsel pertaining to the petition submitted by Mr. Brian Quirk on August 22, 2013 pursuant to § 24-6-1(c) of the Town of North Providence Charter ("charter").**
- 3. Executive Session: Convene in Executive Session to address questions to legal counsel pertaining to the Town of North Providence Charter, art. 24 "Prohibitions." See generally In re Board of Regents for Elementary and Secondary Education Appeals Committee, AGO ADV OM 13-1 (R.I. A.G., March 1, 2013); In re Bozyan v. Middletown Town Council, OM 11-18 (R.I. A.G., July 6, 2011).**
- 4. Open Session: Move into open session for a regular meeting to open the hearing on the petition, to discuss the petition (and supporting documents), and to possibly vote on the petition pursuant**

to § 24-6-1 of the charter. PLEASE NOTE HOWEVER THAT THE HEARING MAY HAVE TO BE CLOSED in accordance with § 24-6-1(c) of the charter, which provides that “[t]he hearing shall be open to the public unless the accused person requests in writing that the hearing be closed.” As of the time this notice was posted, the board had not received from the accused person a written request that the hearing be closed. It is thus the expectation of the board that the hearing shall be open. However, if a written request to close the hearing to the public is received by the board after the posting of this notice, then the hearing shall be closed to the public in accordance with § 24-6-1(c) of the charter and R.I.G.L. §§ 42-46-4 and 42-46-5(a)(1), (2), & (4).
