DIRECTIONS TO THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON DISABILITIES

From Interstate 95 take Route 37 West to Exit 2 A (onto New London Avenue).

At the first stoplight (Howard Avenue) turn left into the grounds of the John O. Pastore Center

Turn at the first left onto Slate Hill Road, park in the lot across from the office.

- Disability parking spaces: on right side of road next to the ramp to the office; and
- Standard parking spaces: on left side of the road across from the ramp.
