OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Noll was notified that only caution buoys were going to be placed, not lights, in front of the railroad bridge. The lights were not going to be replaced due to expense; the bridge is coming down in the near future.

Mr. Carr made a motion that the town dock be splashed by May 15, 2005. Mr. Costa seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously. Mr. Carr will contact the head of Public Works to Schedule.

Mr. Perkins made a motion that the TH&CWMC review the previous recommendations regarding Cory Lane: the towns transfer of Cory

Lane to Starr Woods in return for public access on Schooner Drive (Formerly Dike Street), and the public's write-of way to the water on said Drive. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Mr. Perkins made a motion that a report be submitted to the TH&CWMC from the Town Administrator concerning the development of the repair to Stone Bridge to date and in the future the TH&CWMC be notified on a monthly basis of further development (s). Mr. Costa seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Mr. Carr asked for volunteers from the TH&CWMC to form a committee to review parking along Riverside Drive and then propose a parking plan along said drive to the committee. The committee will consist of: Mr. Stewart (401.625.5833) and Mr. Noll (401.624.1992) with advisors Mr. Hilton (401.624.4075) and Mr. Smith (401.624.8253). A progress report is requested at the May 5, 2005 meeting.

Mr. Wehle made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Costa. Meeting adjourned at 2115.
