OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Carr will write a letter to the RIDOT about the possibility of parking under the current Route 24 Bridge to help alleviate the parking situation along Riverside Drive and continuing on along Main road to Stone Bridge.

Stone Bridge abutment update- There is about \$500K available now for the repair of Stone Bridge abutment. Mr. Carr would like to thank Mr. Sterne and Mr. Wehle for helping to attain these additional funds.

Mr. Carr will write a letter to CRMC asking for the parking plan of businesses, along Riverside Drive and continuing on along Main Road to Stone Bridge.

Mr. Smith challenged the TH&CWMC's approval of the Tiverton Yacht Club's parking approval the night of October 2, 2004. Mr. Carr suggested that the TH&CWMC review again, the Tiverton Yacht Club's parking plan at the January 13, 2005 meeting. Mr. Carr will write a letter to the Tiverton Yacht Club and CRMC inviting them for the review. Mr. McEwing will copy and send to the TH&CWMC members all information on the parking plan for the Tiverton Yacht Club.
