The Very architectural firm will file a quote for a conceptual plan this week. Gifford Architectural firm has already filed a quote to develop a master plan and proposal for a grant to the DEM.

The new basketball poles and nets are up and Bob Martin reported the nets are defected and the company is sending him replacements.

Diana Toste reported the proposed Farmer's Market at Pardon Gray is still in discussion with area farmers and may begin in fall 2008.

Reports of vandalism, graffiti and attempted fires at Pocasset schools fields reported by Ken DeCosta and neighbors near the fields.

Language for signs for the Recreation areas has been approved by the town attorneys. The wording was unanimously approved by TRC and Bob Martin will get the signs made.

Ken DeCosta reported an incident at a little league game when a parent came on the field and verbally assaulted harassed both

officials. A player threw equipment at the same game. Little League has a zero tolerance policy of this behavior by parents, players, or spectators at any games. The TRC unanimously supported consequences outlined in the policies of Little League of exclusion of those violating these policies.

A discussion for a volunteer for the chairing a subcommittee for fundraising was tabled until July's meeting.

Discussion of usage fees for town fields was tabled until July's meeting.
