For Decision: Class B/BX, Food Dispenser, Holiday License and Entertainment; A.A.T. Restaurant Corp., Inc., d/b/a Pulse; 86 Crary Street, Unit W-1; for violation of an incident which occurred on November 24, 2005, at approximately 1:30 hours. At that time, a fight erupted inside the establishment on the dance floor area between females. Shortly afterward, a second disturbance took place involving a large group of males. They were removed by the club security staff. The group again began to fight while in the parking lot and were dispersed by police. Minutes later, the group, who had left the parking area, were observed returning towards the club and advanced towards police. Additional officers from around the city were called to respond to assist the detail officer. While officers were responding to the disturbance, they observed two males standing on the corner of Frank and Beacon Streets. One of the males was stuffing a chrome revolver in the front of his pants wristband. The subjects were apprehended after a foot chase and charged with Possession of a Firearm Without a License and Receiving Stolen Goods (stolen firearm).
