To Appear- Extension of Hours: Class B/BX, Class N, Food Dispenser and Holiday License; A.A.T. Restaurant Corp., d/b/a Pulse; 86 Crary St, Unit W-1; Saturday/Sunday August 27, 2006, to open at 3:00 a.m., for a breakfast fundraiser to benefit Aids Care Ocean State. No Alcohol will be served after 2 am and a police detail will be requested.

Show Cause Hearing: Class B/BX, Class N, Food Dispenser and Holiday Licenses; Concert Club, Inc., d/b/a The Complex, 180 Pine Street, 1st & 2nd Floors; for an incident which occurred on June 3, 2006. At approximately 025 hours, police observed a subject who was being escorted out of the Complex pick up a metal stanchion and throw it at an employee of the nightclub. Police attempted to arrest the subject but the subject broke free and fled.

Ten minutes later while police were standing in front of the Complex a black Ford P/U pulled up and stopped, rolled down the driver's window and gave police the middle finger. The driver was recognized as the same subject who was removed from the club and threw the metal object at the club employee.

The vehicle then fled up Pine Street and was stopped in traffic at Pine and Chestnut. As police approached the vehicle the operator mounted the sidewalk striking Sgt. Aspinall with the trucks mirror assembly. The vehicle continued to travel on the sidewalk striking Ptlm. Annis who suffered a leg injury. The operator was apprehended a short distance away and charged with two counts of Assault on a Police Officer. Refer to Police Report #06-63027.
