Re: HOURS OF OPERATION FOR LIQUOR LICENSE
ESTABLISHMENTS ON NEW YEARS EVE/DAY

The following is a schedule adopted by the members of the Providence Board of Licenses, giving the authority under R. I. General Laws 5-22-3 for the hours of operation for liquor license establishments on New Years Eve, December 31, 2014.

1. **CLASS A LIQUOR LICENSE** closed on Thursday, January 1, 2015.
2. **CLASS B LIQUOR LICENSE** (without BX License) may remain open until 2AM on New Years Eve.
3. **CLASS B LIQUOR LICENSE** (with BX License) may remain open until 3AM on New Years Eve.
4. **CLASS C LIQUOR LICENSE** may operate from 12 Noon to 12 Midnight on New Years Day (January 1, 2015).
5. **CLASS D LIQUOR LICENSE** may remain open until 2AM on New Years Eve.
6. **CLASS ED LIQUOR LICENSE** (without EDX License) may remain open until 2AM on New Years Eve.
7. **CLASS ED LIQUOR LICENSE** (with EDX License) may remain open until 3AM on New Years Eve.

Please note that pursuant to state law and pursuant to Department of Business Regulation Rule 18, notwithstanding the extension of hours on New Year's Eve, **alcoholic beverages are not permitted to be sold beyond the usual time as permitted by law; for example Class B – 1 am; Class BX – 2 am.**
